

CHAPTER I

SCHOOL DISTRICTS ESTABLISHED BY FRENCH-SPEAKING SETTLERS IN ALBERTA: 1885-1939

NEED FOR THIS BOOK.

The history of the school districts established by French-speaking settlers in Alberta between 1885 to 1939 has been neglected. The writer therefore carried out an extensive study of primary source materials at the Provincial Archives of Alberta in order to compile a list of the school districts registered by Francophones from the period 1885 to 1939 and to establish: where these districts were located; when they were organized; what happened to them over the years; and who were the trustees, chairmen, secretary-treasurers and teachers who served these districts. The data compiled on the bilingual school districts (1) can be found in Chapter II of this book. Presumably, this data and the archival reference guide for each bilingual school district will provide groundwork information for researchers interested in studying the history of Francophone education.

This chapter begins with a summary of the methodology used for selecting and validating the data for each bilingual school district. The limitations of this book are then explained, and the "asterisk" coding system used to distinguish the school districts for which there is a lack of primary source materials is detailed. This chapter concludes with a brief description as to what happened to the bilingual school districts after 1939.

METHODOLOGY.

A variety of primary and secondary source materials were examined and analyzed for the purpose of compiling and verifying the list of the 118 school districts registered by French-speaking settlers in Alberta from 1885 to 1939 (see Appendix A). Field notes were kept for each district identified. A method of comparative analysis was utilized to verify the data. This meant that as each new piece of evidence for a school district was uncovered, it was compared with the data from other documents. In the data analysis process, a set of criteria was applied to determine if the school district identified had been registered and administered by Francophones.

Primary Source Materials Consulted and Compared.

The following archival materials and documents were scrutinized and compared for drawing up and verifying the list of bilingual school districts:

1. "L'Association des Instituteurs (Educateurs) Bilingues de l'Alberta" collection at the Provincial Archives of Alberta. This collection contains two important documents which were used for compiling a preliminary list of school districts established by Francophones prior to 1929, namely, "Ecoles Bilingues" dated 1927, and "Liste des districts scolaires bilingues de l'Alberta" dated 1929 (Accession No. 80.226/485 and 80.226/488).
2. Documents at the Provincial Archives of Alberta such as: Denise Stocco's (1973) "French-Canadian Colonization in Alberta;" the card index "Historical Survey of School Districts;" and Dale Holtslander's (1979) list of "School Districts in Alberta."

3. The "Reports of the Board of Education for the Northwest Territories" which are available at the Saskatchewan Archives Board, and on microfilm at Provincial Archives of Alberta (Accession No. 72.275/1).

4. The "Annual Reports of the Department of Education of the Province of Alberta" from 1906 to the 1960's can be found at the Provincial Archives of Alberta the Faculté Saint-Jean Library, University of Alberta.

5. Other collections or documents searched at the Provincial Archives of Alberta included: the Oblate Fathers' collection; the Sisters' of Assumption collection; "L'Association Canadienne-Française 1'Alberta" collection which contains Father Fortier reports of his visits to bilingual school districts between 1934 to 1939 (Accession No. 80.226); the Department of Education Correspondence collection of Meetings for school districts; School Register Cash Books; County records, and the photograph collection.

6. Local histories of communities settled by French-speaking settlers were consulted as were books, theses, and articles on the North-West Territories and Alberta.

Criteria for Selecting School Districts.

To ascertain if a school district could be categorized as a bilingual school district, the following six validate guided the data analysis process:

1. Is there evidence which suggests that French-speaking settlers registered the school district in quest so, when was the district organized, where was it and what eventually happened to it (was it disorganized, did it undergo a name change, and in what school was it consolidated)?

2. Is there evidence which suggests that Francophones were elected as trustees, chairmen or secretary-treasurers of the district in question, and that they were

responsible for administering the district? If so, what were their names and during which period of time did they serve the district?

3. Is there evidence which suggests that the trustees hired or attempted to hire French or bilingual teachers? What were their names and when did they teach in the district?

4. Is there evidence which suggests that French was taught in the school district in accordance with the regulations governing the teaching of French (2), or that French was used for teaching religion or prayers? Are there any references which suggest that a French curriculum or French textbooks were used in the district?

5. Is there evidence which suggests that French was used during school district meetings, or in the administration of school business, and/or between the teacher and students, or between students in their interactions inside or outside of the classroom?

6. Is there evidence which suggests that the administration of the school district in question may have changed over time as a result of the settlement of non-Francophones in the area?

Field notes of data supporting the above questions, kept for each school district, were then analyzed, categorized and stored in the computer for the purpose of data reporting.

DATA LIMITATIONS.

The scarcity of archival materials for certain school districts prevented the writer from completing the list of names of school trustees and teachers who served the bilingual school districts (see Chapter II), and from satisfying some of the criteria identified in the sub-section, "Criteria for Selecting School Districts."

The lack of the following primary source materials limited the data gathering process on the school districts registered by French-speaking settlers: documents pertaining to the school districts registered by Francophones during the North-West Territories period; correspondence prior to 1932 between the Alberta Department of Education and the bilingual school districts; gaps in the correspondence after 1932 between the Alberta Department of Education and the bilingual school districts; and Minutes of Meetings and School Registers for these districts.

The "Asterisk" Coding System.

The 118 school districts listed in this book were validated as having been registered by French-speaking settlers, and of these, 85 districts satisfied most of the criteria identified in the sub-section, "Criteria for Selecting School Districts." Because of a lack of primary source materials, 33 school districts did not meet some of the major criteria. A coding system of placing either one (*) or two (**) asterisks before the name of a school district was devised in order to draw to the reader's attention the districts which did not meet certain criteria.

Out of the 33 school districts identified as not satisfying certain criteria, there were 22 districts for which the limited data suggested that the administration of these districts was eventually shared between Francophones and other ethnic groups, or that French

was not consistently taught in the district for a variety of reasons. These 22 districts are prefixed with one (*) asterisk in this book. The 11 school districts prefixed with two (**) asterisks are those for which the lack of primary source materials impeded the writer from confirming that Francophones consistently administered these districts, or that French was used as a language of instruction.

Other Bilingual School Districts to be Confirmed.

Some data was found which indicated that French-speaking settlers may have registered an additional nine school districts. Because of inconclusive evidence, these districts were not included in the list of the 118 bilingual school districts in this book.

The nine districts which may have been registered by Francophones are as follows: St. Joachim Roman Catholic Separate S.D. No. 7 (Edmonton) registered in 1889; Granger Roman Catholic Separate S.D. No. 42 (Rivière-qui-Barre) registered in 1895; Boulais Roman Catholic Public S.D. No. 47, which became Volmer S.D. No. 47, (Rivière-qui-Barre); Trochu Valley S.D. No. 1742 (Trochu) registered in 1907; Tinchebray S.D. No. 1918 (Red Deer area) registered in 1909; Guibault S.D. No. 2885 (St. Albert) registered in 1913; Flat Creek S.D. No. 3106 (Donatville) registered in 1914; Roberge S.D. No. 3900 (St. Edouard) registered in 1920; and the Fort Vermilion Roman Catholic Separate S.D. No. 26 (Fort Vermilion) registered in 1923.

A private school known as Ecole Theroux was established in 1918 by Francophones in Warwick, in the vicinity of Ben's Lake (the Two Lakes area). This school remained open for 15 years and offered a curriculum in the French language (3).

SCHOOL DISTRICT CONSOLIDATION.

Consolidation involved the joining together of several school districts into larger units called school divisions. The first School Divisions in Alberta began operation in January, 1937 (4), and by 1940 Alberta had all of its 3,472 rural schools, with the exception of 180 districts, consolidated into 46 Divisions (5).

French-speaking settlers had registered 118 school districts in the Alberta area between 1885 to 1939. Eighteen of these districts were registered prior to 1905 in twelve geographic areas (see Appendix B), and 100 districts were registered between 1905 to 1939 in 50 geographic areas (see Appendix C). With the move in the 1940's toward consolidation, 84 bilingual school districts were integrated into sixteen school divisions.

The 84 bilingual school districts were consolidated into the following school divisions: Castor School Division No. 6; Vegreville School Division No. 19; Two Hills School Division No. 21; Sturgeon School Division No. 24; Leduc (County) School Division No. 25; Pincher Creek School Division No. 29; Westlock School Division No.

37; Wheatland School Division No. 40; Athabasca School Division No. 42; Wainright School Division No. 42; St. Paul School Division No. 45; Bonnyville School Division No. 46; Spirit River School Division No. 47; McLennan School Division No. 48; High Prairie School Division No. 48, and Lac La Biche School Division No. 51 (see Appendix D).

Two school districts out of the 118 districts were disorganized prior to consolidation, namely, Creuzot Roman Catholic Public S.D. No. 34 and Picardville S.D. No. 1901. Due to the lack of information on 32 school districts, the writer was unable to determine what happened to them. There is data which suggests that Falher Consolidated School District No. 69, Guy Roman Catholic Separate School District No. 30, and the Thibault Roman Catholic Public School District No. 35 may not have been consolidated. Further research would have to be undertaken to establish what happened to these 32 districts.

CONCLUSION.

The 118 bilingual school districts identified in this book were determined by a method of comparative analysis and were confirmed by a validation process which sought proof that these districts were registered and administered by Francophones, and that French was taught in the district according to the regulations governing the teaching of French.

The major limitation of this study was the scarcity of primary source materials at the Provincial Archives of Alberta for certain school districts. An "asterisk" coding system was used to make the reader aware of the districts for which there was limited data. An additional nine school districts may have been registered by Francophones, but due to a lack of sufficient evidence they have been omitted in Chapter II. There is therefore a need to continue the search for primary source materials on bilingual school districts.

Chapter II of this book provides descriptive data on the bilingual school districts and a reference guide to archival materials for each of these districts. These archival materials may be of interest to those who wish to pursue research on the history of Francophone education. These data sources, once analyzed, could yield important insights and hypotheses on the relationships between school governance, school administration, and the maintenance of the French language and culture.

REFERENCES

1. The term bilingual school district was used by Alberta Department of Education officials when referring to school districts in localities where there was a concentration of French-speaking people whose trustees had authorized the teaching of a Primary course in French (see reference no. 2).

2. The regulations governing the teaching of French began during the North-West Territories period with Ordinance No. 22, Articles 83 and 84 in 1892. Ordinance No. 22 declared English as the language of instruction and made it permissible for trustees to authorize a Primary course to be taught in French. A Primary course was generally interpreted as the first two years of schooling. This particular Ordinance remained in effect after Alberta became a Province and was known by 1925 as Section 184 of The School Act, and by 1936 as Section 146 of The School Act. This section stated as follows:

In all schools in which the board by resolution decides to offer a primary course in French, in accordance with Sec. 184 of the School Ordinance, French shall be for the French-speaking children one of the authorized subjects of study and may be used as a medium of instruction for other subjects during the first school year. Oral English must, however, from the beginning be included in the curriculum as a subject of study.

During the second year and after the child has learned to read in the mother tongue, the formal teaching of reading in English shall be begun (Twentieth Annual Report of the Department of Education of the Province of Alberta, 1925. (1926) Edmonton: King's Printer, p. 27).

Beyond the Primary grades Section 184 stated that French could be taught for a period of one hour per day as follows:

From Grade III on, a period not exceeding one hour each day may be allotted to the teaching of French. The term "French" as herein used shall include reading, language study, grammar, analysis, dictation, and composition (Instructions Concerning the Teaching of French in the Elementary Schools of the Province of Alberta. 1925).
